

# Lesson 27

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## Materials:

- ◆ Alphabet flashcards
- ◆ Sight word flashcards
- ◆ Color word flashcards
- ◆ Shape word flashcards
- ◆ Worksheet 31

## Skills:

- ❖ Review the previous consonant sounds.
  - ◆ Using flashcards, review the previous consonant sounds.
  - ◆ Have the child list a word beginning with each letter.
- ❖ Review the short vowel sounds of **Aa, Ee, Ii, Oo**.
  - ◆ Using flashcards, review the short vowel sounds.
- ❖ Review the sight words, color words, and shape words.
  - ◆ Using flashcards, review the words.
- ❖ Understand that an exclamation point is used to express excitement, surprise, or strong emotion.
  - ◆ Have your child read the first sentence on worksheet 27 part A. Point out the exclamation point at the end of the sentence.
  - ◆ Explain that it is a punctuation mark used to express excitement, surprise, or strong emotion.
  - ◆ Have your child read the sentence again and put expression into his voice so that a listener could hear the emotion.
  - ◆ Look at the next two sentences on the worksheet. Ask the child to identify the punctuation mark at the end of each.
    - Mom said, "Pat is there." (period)*
    - Is the fox red? (question mark)*
  - ◆ Ask the child, "When do you use a period?" (*Use a period to make a statement or tell something.*) "When do you use a question mark?" (*Use a question mark to ask a question.*)
  - ◆ Have the child practice reading the sentences with fluency and expression. At the end of a statement the reader's voice should drop. At the end of a question a reader's voice should rise.
  - ◆ Have the child read the sentences in part B and fill in the correct punctuation mark.
    - Are you in the brown box?
    - There is a lid on the pot.
    - Get the dog off there now!

## Independent practice:

- ◆ Worksheet 27 part A and B: Read the sentences again.
- ◆ Worksheet 27 part C: Listen to each sentence that is read to you. Write it on the lines. Use correct punctuation and capital letters. Have the child correct any errors.
  1. Is there a bug in here?
  2. This is a lot of fun!
  3. There is a black lid on the pot.
  - \* Challenge sentence: Dad said, "The meat is still red."

Sample error corrections:                      *black*

There is a ~~blak~~ lid on the pot ~~!~~.
- ◆ Have the child read the worksheet several times.
